The Radiation Control Inspectorate is committed to supporting the empowerment of youth, in line with the Government's youth initiative by providing opportunities to young graduates to hone their knowledge and skills in applied radiation protection and nuclear science techniques through short term volunteer programs.

Currently, RCI has limited opportunities for candidates who meet the following requirements:

1. Availability for the duration of the programme (not less than three months but not exceeding 6 months),
2. Be a graduate with relevant degree obtained from a recognized institution within the last five (5) years,
3. Should not be more than 35 years old,
4. Should have a valid health insurance cover, preferably by the National Hospital Insurance Fund (NHIF),
5. Should have a valid certificate of good conduct from the Directorate of Criminal Investigation,
6. Should be in a position to support himself/herself during the entire duration of the programme (proof of support will be required)
